**ITEM NO. 1: (a) Address by the Chairman**

The Chairman welcomed the members to the meeting.

**ITEM NO.2: Confirmation of the SAC Minutes of the last meeting held on 16.11.2004**

No comments were received and hence the minutes of the last meeting held on 16.11.2004 were confirmed as circulated.

**ITEM NO. 3: Matters arising out of minutes**

**(a) MCM Scholarship**

The Director informed the Council that a proposal to increase the Guardian's income from present limit of Rs. 1 lakh per annum is under consideration of IIT Council. Moreover, it was discussed that making the House Secretary the member of Standing Committee for MCM is not helpful in identifying bogus claims.

**(b) Hospital Timings**

The Council was informed that 12.00 noon to 1.00 P.M. has been fixed for the priority of students, in the hospital. Also, regarding the availability of the specialist in the hospital the Council was informed that from now on a specialist will be seeing 5 new patients in his every visit.

**(c) Access to the IIT server from outside the IIT campus**

The Council was informed that the access to ACSS server which is used for registration will not be allowed access from outside the IIT campus. Moreover, the Council discussed that access to the e-mail accounts from outside the IIT campus should be provided.

**ITEM NO. 4: Grading System in IIT Delhi**

As the problem will be common for all IITs, it will be taken up at Directors meeting.

The Dean PGS&R informed the Council that as per the Senate meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2003, the tuition fees for the final year of dual degree students should be at par with tuition the fees of the M. Tech students.
