

STUDENT AFFAIRS COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting held on 16.10.2012

The meeting was chaired by Prof. R. K. Shevgaonkar, Director, IIT Delhi. It was the first meeting under the tenure of Prof S.K.Gupta as the Dean of Students.

The following agenda points were discussed:

1. Confirmation of the minutes of meeting held on 23.04.2012.

2. Restructuring of Boards & Constituion Review

Mainly, restructuring of the BSP was discussed. Although, majority of the members present felt that it was necessary to restructure the board, but it could not be clearly demarcated what were the demerits of the existing system and how the new system would help in solving them. SAC GSec. was asked to present these things in a tabular form in order to be more understandable with the whole new structure. The same was marked to be taken up in the next meeting.

3. Married Students' Hostels

- **Renovation delays in Nalanda:** Second phase is ready for A-type houses.
- **Progress on construction of new Married Students' Hostel :** It is in pipeline and will be completed
- **Internet connection & parking shed in NV:** Prof. S K Gupta, Dean, Student Affairs will be overlooking the whole thing.
- **Sanction of water cooler and purifier in NV :** Prof. S K Gupta, Dean, Student Affairs will be overclooking the whole thing.

The married students' representative is marked to follow up on this item.

4. Use of plastic in campus: The SAC G Sec was requested to setup a Committee that would look at alternatives to plastic cups etc used in campus.

5. Bills by food/retail outlets in IIT: It was decided that a circular will be sent to all the outlets notifying them with the necessity of issuing the bills. The Satpura Rep was marked to follow up.

6. Opening of Kailash Gate at night: Prof. S.N.Singh said that he will look into the matter and also discuss it with Kailash hostel's Warden. The Kailash House Secy was marked to followup.

7. Problem associated with IITD Hospital: The Council was informed that a panel of 4 members has already been constituted to oversee the recruitment of additional doctors through walk-in immediate interviews. Also, Prof. R. K. Shevgaonkar, Director promised that during the months of August-November, additional doctors will be appointed to minimize the long queues. The Deputy Director also mentioned that negotiations are on to permanently book some hospital rooms in nearby hospitals for IIT students and about increasing the shift duration of the doctors.

8. Differed Placement Programme: A committee will be setup that will design a program to meet the needs. The SAC G Sec was marked to follow up. with CAIC G Sec.
